POSITION SUMMARY

Provides counseling, primarily remotely, for men and women dealing with post-abortion or crisis pregnancy situations. As a ministry of Lutherans For Life, Word of Hope provides Gospel-motivated counseling, and its Director will be well-equipped to proclaim God's forgiveness and healing to those in painful life circumstances. This position reports to the National Director of Lutherans For Life.

Ability to write and speak on topics related to Word of Hope crisis pregnancy situations, post-abortion syndrome, etc. to audiences of all levels through Lutheran publications, on college campuses, in Lutheran schools and churches and other schools and churches as the opportunities present themselves
- 5. Able to establish good working relationships with other professionals: pastors, social workers, deaconesses, parish nurses, other medical and counseling professionals, etc.
- 6. Able to work within a team at Lutherans For Life
- 7. Work with technology tools: Outlook and Word primarily, but PowerPoint and Excel to a lesser degree
- 8. Self-starter and self-motivated
